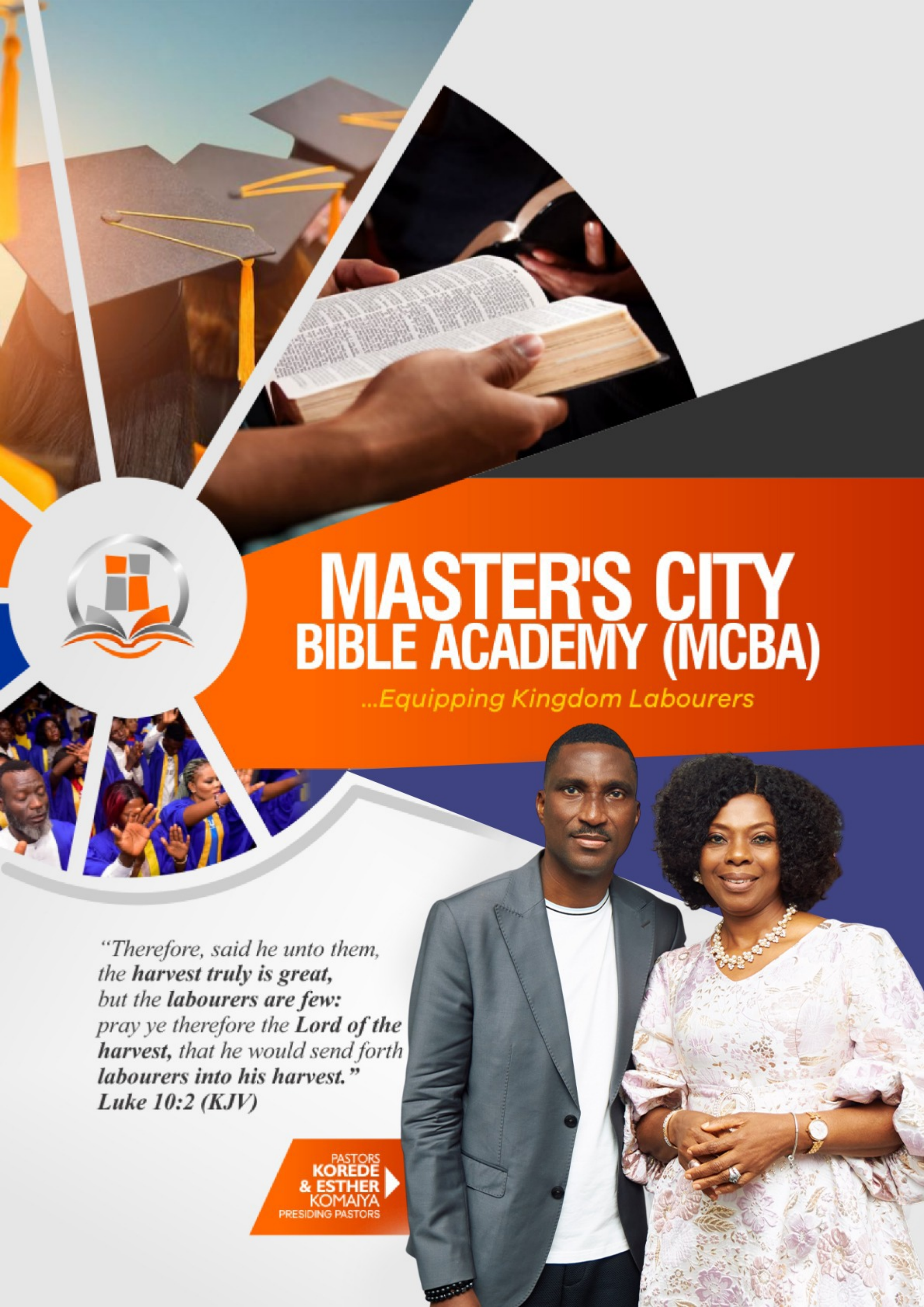

THE ACADEMIC & MINISTRY JOURNEY

1 YEAR OF INTENSIVE MINISTRY TRAINING

The programme runs for a cumulative period of 1 Year — Nine (9) months of Academic work, structured across three semesters and Three Months of hands-on practicals.

SEMESTER ONE — FOUNDATION & SPIRITUAL FORMATION (January – April)

The first semester establishes the spiritual, biblical and ministerial foundations required for effective Kingdom service.

SEMESTER TWO — MINISTRY DEVELOPMENT & LEADERSHIP (May – July)

The second semester focuses on practical ministry, leadership, pastoral responsibility, church systems and effective service.

SEMESTER THREE — MINISTRY EQUIPPING & KINGDOM ADVANCEMENT (August – October)

The third semester equips students with the knowledge and competencies required to advance the Kingdom.

MINISTRY PRACTICAL & KINGDOM DEPLOYMENT (November – January)

Intensive practical ministry immersion, field assignments, ministry attachment, evangelism, outreach, leadership practice, ministry projects and final assessment.

BEYOND THE PULPIT

Because Ministry Will Require More Than a Message

At MCBA, students will discover that effective ministry will extend far beyond the pulpit. They will be equipped with the wisdom, competence, spiritual capacity and practical understanding required to build sustainable works that will impact lives, communities, cities and nations.

They will be exposed to the realities of building ministry from generating and managing resources for the work of God, to understanding legal frameworks, acquiring land and developing structures that will facilitate Kingdom advancement.

FINANCE IN MINISTRY - Generating Resources for the Work of God.

Students will learn how resources will be generated, stewarded and deployed strategically for the advancement of God's work.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT IN MINISTRY - Stewarding What God Will Entrust

Students will gain practical understanding of financial management, accountability, stewardship and responsible resource administration in ministry.

ESTATE & STRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT - The Place of Land Acquisition

Students will understand the strategic role that land, facilities and physical structures will play in establishing and expanding sustainable ministry expressions.

LEGAL FRAMEWORK FOR MINISTRY - Understanding the Laws of the Land

Students will be introduced to the legal realities that will govern ministry organisations and learn

principles that will help them establish, protect and administer ministry works responsibly.

THE ANOINTING & IMPARTATION - The Master Key to Everything in Ministry

Students will be taught the realities of the anointing and the place of spiritual empowerment and impartation in effective ministry. They will understand that beyond knowledge, strategy and skill, Kingdom assignment will require spiritual empowerment.

LOYALTY - Raising Faithful Men for the Work of the Ministry

Students will be challenged to understand loyalty as a critical foundation for sustainable ministry. They will be formed in faithfulness, commitment, submission, honour and responsibility; qualities that will prepare them to become trustworthy labourers who can be entrusted with people, assignments and Kingdom responsibility.

BIBLICAL KNOWLEDGE

A stronger understanding of Scripture and foundational Christian doctrine.

SPIRITUAL MATURITY

A deeper prayer life, stronger spiritual discipline and greater sensitivity to the things of God.

CHARACTER

Greater integrity, humility, discipline, loyalty, responsibility and emotional maturity.

MINISTRY COMPETENCE

The ability to serve more effectively in practical ministry environments.

LEADERSHIP

The capacity to lead people, teams and assignments responsibly.

EVANGELISM

Greater confidence and effectiveness in communicating the Gospel and winning souls.

PASTORAL CAPACITY

An understanding of shepherding, discipleship, counselling and caring for people.

CHURCH DEVELOPMENT

A foundational understanding of church growth, church administration and church planting.

KINGDOM MINDSET

A deeper understanding of the believer's responsibility to advance God's Kingdom.
